You are approved to operate an Alternative High School Equivalency Preparation Program for 16-18 year olds (16 year olds only who have reached the mandatory attendance age). The program must operate a minimum of 12 hours per week.

This program code should be used by all students in your Alternative High School Equivalency Preparation Program when they are completing item 2 of the Application for the High School Equivalency Diploma and GED Testing. Including the program code along with a letter on your official school stationery from your program certifying the student's participation in AHSEPP and demonstration of readiness to test, will allow the students to be eligible and scheduled to take the GED Test. This letter must have an original signature of the program coordinator or teacher.
